

CATHOLIC Q & A: TRIDUUM

Question: I haven't attended Triduum services before. What happens that's different from a normal Sunday Mass?

Answer: The liturgies during Triduum are unique and rich in symbolism. The Holy Thursday Mass follows the rhythm of the ancient Last Supper. The presider washes the feet of members of the congregation, like Jesus washed the feet of the disciples. After Mass, all remaining hosts are taken to an altar of repose, where adoration of the Blessed Sacrament occurs late into the night. Parishioners can remain like the disciples in Gethsemane, asked to "watch and pray."

On Good Friday, we celebrate another special liturgical service. Following the Liturgy of the Word, there is a communal reverencing of the cross. The intercessions are solemn and include prayers for many different groups of people, reminding us that Jesus' passion is for the whole world. There is no Liturgy of the Eucharist. Hosts consecrated on Holy Thursday are distributed, after which the tabernacle is empty. The tabernacle remains empty through Holy Saturday — just as Jesus departed from this earthly world in death — and we wait in hope for Easter Sunday! ©LPi

CATHOLIC Q & A: BLESSED PALMS FOR PALM SUNDAY

Question: Where do Palm Sunday palms come from and where should they go?

Answer: The Palm Sunday celebration has ancient origins. Beginning the liturgy "outside" the church, we symbolically reenact Christ's entry into Jerusalem. The crowds in ancient Israel waved palm branches — a symbol of royalty — to welcome Jesus.

These days, obtaining palms takes a lot of planning and coordination, as hundreds of thousands of churches worldwide need them on the same day! Many in the United States order palms from Florida, California, Texas, or Central America. Many companies stress the sustainability of their production and the just wages paid to their workers.

The palms used on Palm Sunday are blessed at Mass. This means they shouldn't end up in the trash! Many people weave palms into crosses or families display them in their homes. If you do not plan on displaying your palms throughout the year, they should be burned, buried, or left at the church. In the final case, the palms are burned to provide the ashes for next year's Ash Wednesday service. ©LPi

HOLY THURSDAY FOOT WASHING - WHAT TO EXPECT AT OLA

During the washing of the feet, we are invited to imitate Christ's sacrificial service to others.

There will be four foot washing stations in front of the sanctuary. All who wish to participate will be invited to wait in line to approach one of the four foot washing stations. After someone has his/her feet washed, he/she will in turn wash the feet of the next person in line until everyone in the line has had his/her feet washed.

Those having their feet washed should remove their shoes and socks before entering the line and put their shoes and socks back on after returning to their seat.


