

2026 CONSECRATION OF THE UNITED STATES TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

This June, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) will consecrate the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Parishes around the country are encouraged to join the bishops in consecrating our nation to the Sacred Heart.

In the diocese of Sacramento, Bishop Soto is inviting all parishes to complete 250 hours of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament AND 250 Works of Mercy. OLA Parishioners are invited to adore the Blessed Sacrament on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:30am - 7:00pm in the church. Please park in the Walnut Avenue parking lot and enter the church through the rectory side door. Sign in/out using the adoration attendance binder so we can document how many hours of Adoration our parish completes during the month of June.

Here at OLA, we have many opportunities to complete Works of Mercy through participation in our ministries. In the USCCB [*America 250 Catholic Resource*](#), it states: "The seven Corporal Works of Mercy come to us directly from the Scriptures in the Gospel of Matthew. Rooted in our lives of faith, the actions that Jesus calls us to in feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, sheltering the homeless, visiting the sick and imprisoned, burying the dead, and giving alms are central elements of our Catholic identity. Pope Leo XIV instructs in *Dilexi te*, "As we contemplate Christ's love, 'we too are inspired to be more attentive to the sufferings and needs of others, and confirmed in our efforts to share in his work of liberation as instruments for the spread of his love'" (*no. 2*)."

OLA CONFERENCE OF THE ST. VINCENT de PAUL SOCIETY

Thank you for your ongoing support! At Saint Vincent de Paul, the most important resource we can offer our neighbors in need is ourselves - a listening ear, compassion, and empathy. For our volunteers, this comes first and foremost. For many of our clients, this is all they really want - to feel valued, to know someone cares. We also offer resources to help them help themselves because we know that we cannot solve their problems for them. When needed, we provide modest material support - a bag of food, help with rent or utilities.

At other times we receive special requests like the call we got in mid-May. We were contacted by a relative of two adult women who were in dire need of lodging. They had been living in their car which was about to be repossessed. They needed a place to sleep, shower, and think carefully about their next steps. Our volunteers contacted a nearby motel and arranged four nights of lodging. We also provided bags of groceries, personal items, and Thrift Store vouchers, and left them with a list of resources to call once they had rested. Our neighbors were overwhelmed and hugs were shared. We could not solve their problems but hopefully, they know that people care for them and that the resources we provided might help set them on a better path.

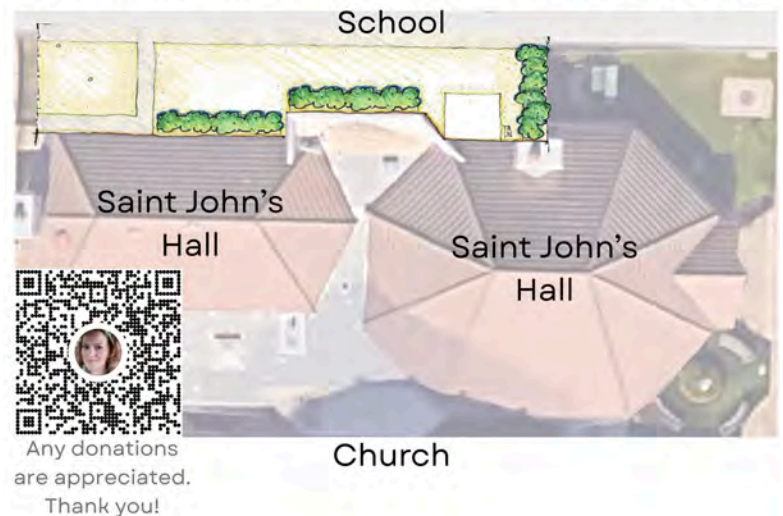
EAGLE SCOUT PROJECT - LANDSCAPING BEHIND ST. JOHN'S HALL
