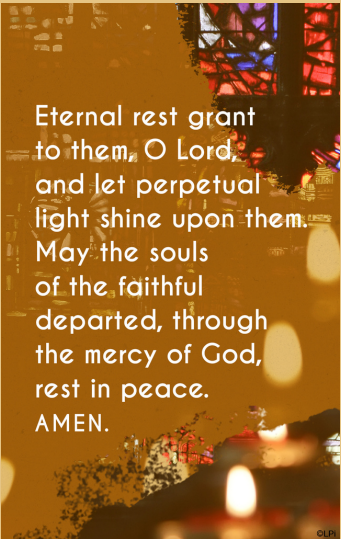

2026 OLA SUMMER RECYCLING CHALLENGE BEGINS THIS WEEKEND!

The OLA Summer Recycling Challenge collection dates are this weekend, July 25th - 26th, and next weekend, August 1st - 2nd. OLA School student Nathan Oliver and several of his 5th grade classmates will be outside under the portico after all of the Masses to collect your donated cans and bottles, and they will take them to the Capital City Recycling Center for redemption. The proceeds will be donated to OLA church and school to assist with recycling and sustainability efforts.

According to the Capital City Recycling Center website, "Consumers pay California Redemption Value (CRV) when they purchase beverages from a retailer and receive CRV refunds when they redeem the containers at a recycling center. Most beverage packaged in aluminum, glass, plastic and bi-metal containers are eligible for CRV."
