SEPTEMBER PRIEST UPDATE

With Labor Day behind us, we look forward to the pleasant time of fall. Despite the departure of our beloved Fr. Eduino and the passing of the unforgettable Fr. Brendan, summer has been a blessed time. As the holy people of God, the family of Our Lady of the Assumption, we have celebrated our faith with joy.

Recently we had a beautiful review of all our liturgical procedures, and minor adjustments in the sanctuary were made to ensure we are following the General Instruction of the Roman Missal. Our dedicated parishioners as Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, and Ushers have carefully perfected their responsibilities. We were also blessed with 48 Altar Servers at a recent training. These young girls and boys learn so quickly and act very reverently with great care to do everything right as they assist the priest in the sacred ministry of the Eucharist. All these ministries work together beautifully as our choirs promote sacred music in the pews, in the body of Christ - celebrating the center of our faith, the Eucharist.

School has resumed with very satisfactory enrollment numbers, and everything is in place for an excellent year ahead. Our young people not in our school have started well in their faith formation classes. The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) has started with an excellent group of 15 people. Charity, as we care for those less fortunate, is never forgotten as our St. Vincent de Paul Society's work is an inspiration to the diocese.

Fr. Alvaro carefully oversees all administrative issues so that the financial and regulation side of the parish are in proper order. Fr. Dane, our Parochial Vicar, has brought many gifts to our parish with reverent and careful celebration of the Eucharist and solid preaching in his quiet, humble style. Fr. Kiernan gently and carefully continues to be of assistance in a variety of ways using his long experience of OLA as a stabilizing influence in this time of transition. CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES

A powerful 7.4 magnitude earthquake struck western Colombia on August 10th, killing 240 people and insuring nearly 4,000. On August 15th, a magnitude 7.7 earthquake struck off the north coast of Indonesia, killing an estimated 70 people, injuring more than 1,000 people and displacing more than 40,000. Venezuela had two back-to-back powerful earthquakes, killing over 6,300 people, injuring over 73,000 and displacing about 18,000.

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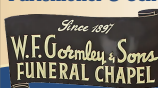
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
