Subject:	Distribution of the Blood of Christ

California has now surpassed the threshold for influenza-like illness. I instruct pastors and parochial administrators in the Diocese of Sacramento to temporarily implement the following protocols:

- 1. Suspend the distribution of the chalice except for:
 - ministering clergy (priests and deacons),
 - those with medical conditions preventing reception of the Holy Eucharist under the form of bread, and
 - those named in particular rites celebrated at Mass (e.g. the couple celebrating matrimony, etc.).
- 2. It is encouraged that all the faithful receive the Sacred Body of Christ in the hand. Receiving on the tongue is permitted.
