Nine-Day Novena for Spiritual Revival in Honor of The Feast Day of Our Lady of the Assumption on August 15

*Please pray the respective day's intention and the Memorare each day August 6-14.
(Novena may be said at any time during the year.)*

DAY	INTENTION
1 (AUG 6)	For our Pastor, Fr. Eduino: That he be encouraged in his priestly ministry at our parish and be provided the necessary resources to remain healthy in mind, body, and spirit.
2 (AUG 7)	For Dcn. Paul: That his ministry as an Ordained Deacon be a joyful blessing to him and his wife as they serve Fr. Eduino and our parish.
3 (AUG 8)	For the parish administrative staff: That as they juggle schedules, needs, and programs for the continued nourishment and growth of OLA, that they will be blessed in their own faith lives.
4 (AUG 9)	For OLA school, staff, students, and volunteers: That our parish school will thrive in the education of the children in all subjects, but especially their tender faith as growing Catholics.
5 (AUG 10)	For the OLA Parish Council: That the relationship between clergy and laity continue to be a happy cooperative venture that fosters the increasing holiness of our church family.
6 (AUG 11)	For all the ministries at OLA: That serving God in the Body of Christ will be a fruitful blessing to those who serve and those who are served.
7 (AUG 12)	For continued Eucharistic Adoration in the church: That at the beginning of this three-year Eucharistic Revival, many parishioners will serve and love their weekly Holy Hour as a source of peace and grace that can only come from God.
8 (AUG 13)	For more vocations from OLA to holy marriages and holy families, the consecrated life, and the diaconate and priesthood.
9 (AUG 14)	For all OLA parishioners: That growing in the knowledge and love of Jesus Christ as baptized Catholics is the "pearl of great price" and that nothing surpasses the joy of being loved by God, as we are all called to be saints.
