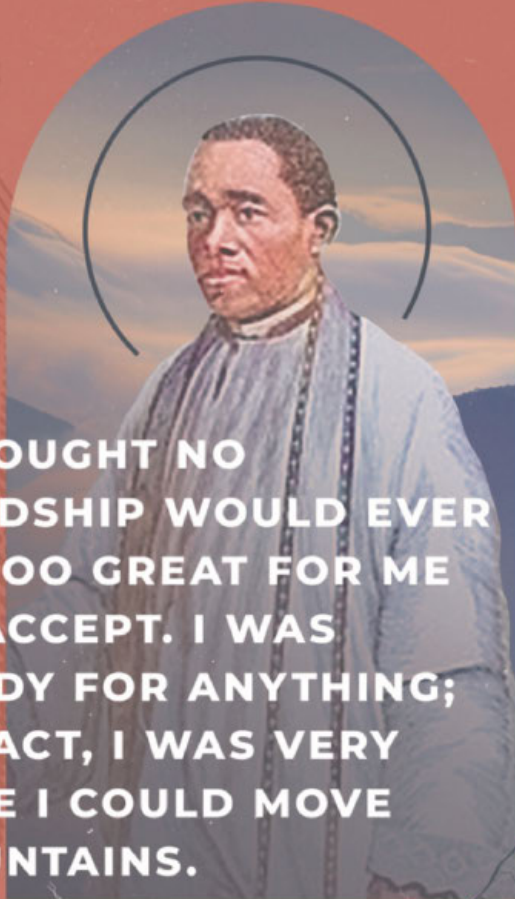

GOSPEL MEDITATION

ADVENT 2024 – WEEK 2: PEACE

We generally translate the word “jihad” as a “holy war.” There is a “greater jihad” and a “lesser jihad.” And when we think of jihad only in terms of a holy war, we might assume the greater jihad as war on a large scale. Not so, a jihad is not about war, rather about struggle. And the greater jihad is about the struggle within our self, our human struggle to build up what is right and to prevent what is wrong, overcoming our passions, our impulses, our temptations.

Peace is a word like jihad, in that we generally think of peace in broad terms of ending the battles we have with each other as individuals, as groups, as nations. We often think of peace in terms of no wars, when we end our disagreements and join in fellowship. And as we prepare for Jesus Christ’s second advent, we yearn and work for a world free of war, free of hate, free of disturbance.

This is a wonderful ideal. But is our preparation only about our great struggle to effect a change to a world with no wars – to not conquer or dominate or oppress others? Perhaps there is a “greater peace.” Jesus spoke to the crowds, yet the greater success was (and is) how he spoke to each of us individually. He searches for each of us in our despair. He searches for each of us in our loneliness. He reaches out to you and to me in our dreams and our hopes. He finds each of us in the quiet. Is finding peace within our self and is opening ourselves to the wonders of the Christ, how we begin to prepare for Jesus’ second coming? In finding peace within, we can build upon that wonderful relationship with Jesus that calls us to share with others so all may find peace. By finding this greater peace within, we open the door to a lesser peace without.

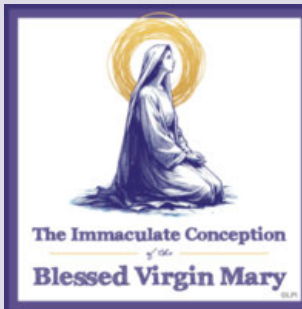

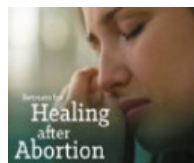
