GOSPEL MEDITATION

Fourth Sunday of Lent

Our national pastime isn't baseball. It's what the Bible calls "condemning the world." We generally enjoy pronouncing curses upon those whom we see as trouble, wrong, or evil. Don't believe me? Listen to almost any podcast, cable news network, or social media platform to hear it. It will be some version of: "We all agree that if they are eradicated, things will be great." Condemning is almost always clothed in virtue. It basks in its good intentions. That's why it is so attractive. Condemning seems like our best path to saving what is good.

What a shock, then, to hear Jesus announce: **"For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him"** (Jn 3:17). He comes to save the world, as we all want, but he will accomplish it without an act of condemnation. How hard it is to accept this! Condemning feels godlike. I judge who and what must be lost to protect the good. But in the light of Jesus' endless mercy and love, this is the least godlike thing we can do.

Lenten challenge: This week, I invite you to give up the delicious experience of condemning whomever in the world you most would like to see gone. Perhaps write down their names. Secondly, I invite you to consider fasting from any media that feeds the tasty but deadly tendency to condemn. -Father John Muir ©LPI

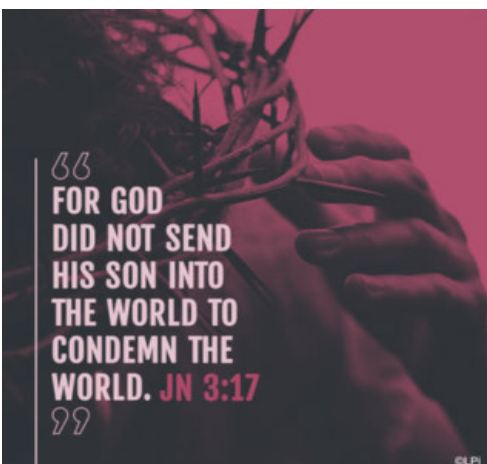

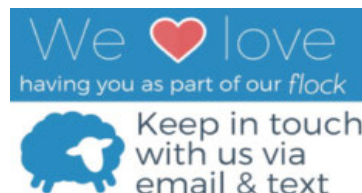

Image of Blessed Carlo Acutis



In the church, you may have noticed there is a new image on the wall next to the Sacred Heart of Jesus statue. Fr. Eduino wanted to inspire the youth of our parish by displaying the image of Blessed Carlo Acutis.

We are all encouraged to follow the example of Blessed Carlo Acutis and his devotion to the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

Sharon Friedrich, wife of Deacon Paul Friedrich, summarized the life of Blessed Carlo Acutis for a display in the Altar Server's room. An informational display will also be placed next to the image in the church.

BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS - A TEENAGE BOY WORKING MIRACLES FROM HEAVEN! *By Sharon Friedrich*

WHO WAS CARLO ACUTIS? A Catholic Italian teenager, a gamer, a computer programmer, a lover of soccer... He was known for his deep devotion to the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist!

LIFE ON EARTH: Born May 3, 1991, in England, Carlo lived in Italy and accomplished many things during his 15 years on earth. He:

- Got his parents to go to daily Mass with him because the Eucharist was so important to him.
- Defended kids who got bullied at school, especially those with disabilities.
- Built a website cataloging and promoting Eucharistic miracles around the world! Carlo said: ***"The more often we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of heaven."***

DEATH: When he became ill with leukemia (a blood cancer), he offered his sufferings for Pope Benedict XVI and the Church. He died on October 12, 2006, and was buried in Assisi, Italy because of his love for St. Francis of Assisi. Carlo's heart (considered a Relic – an object of religious importance) is in a special container in the Basilica of St. Francis there. Carlo's mom gave St. Dominic Parish in Brick, New Jersey a first-class relic on October 1, 2023.

Carlo Acutis' Path To Sainthood

FEAST DAY: OCTOBER 12 ~ PATRON SAINT FOR COMPUTER PROGRAMMERS AND THE YOUTH

After one healing miracle of a young boy named Mattheus was attributed to Carlo's prayers and the grace of God, Carlo Acutis was beatified on October 10, 2020. He is now called "Blessed Carlo Acutis."

One more approved miracle is required for him to be canonized as a Saint in the Catholic Church. We are all called to be Saints and Carlo's mom said: "Sainthood is for everyone. Carlo became a saint by practicing the seven theological and cardinal virtues.... "This is what makes us all saints." We now have a teenager in Heaven who can pray for us. ***Our Lady of the Assumption and Blessed Carlo Acutis, pray for us!***

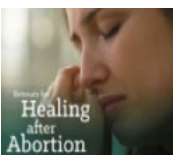


Weekly Meetings at OLA
