



PARISH AND SCHOOL NEWS

OCIA (ORDER OF CATHOLIC INITIATION FOR ADULTS) UPDATES



On Sunday, February 22, the catechumens (those to be baptized at the Easter Vigil Mass) participated in the Rite of Sending at the 9 A.M. Mass, during which Father Eduino accepted their desire to enter the Catholic Church and sent them to be presented before Bishop Rey at the Rite of Election at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament on Sunday evening. During the Rite of Election, which takes place at multiple churches throughout the first weekend of Lent, all of the catechumens from the Diocese of Sacramento were presented to Bishop Rey and Bishop Soto as they prepared to receive the sacraments of initiation.

On Saturday, February 28, the OCIA candidates (those already baptized and preparing to receive the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation at Easter) participated in the Rites of Call to Continuing Conversion and Penance. These rites acknowledge that they have already been washed of Original Sin at their baptisms and are prepared to receive Reconciliation to prepare for the final sacraments of initiation.

Please continue to keep those participating in OCIA in your prayers as they draw closer to Easter and the catechumens prepare for the scrutinies the next three weeks.




