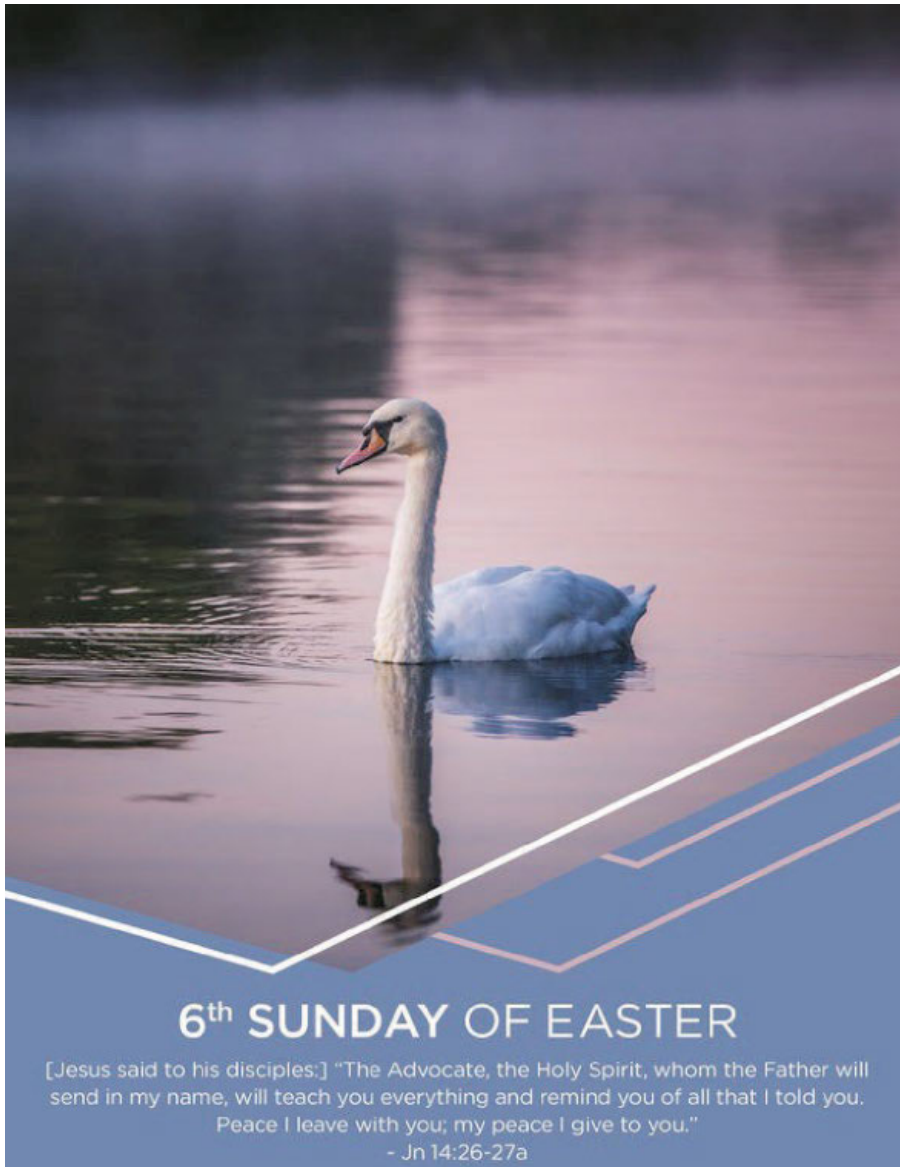

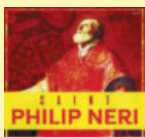
Parish Mission Statement

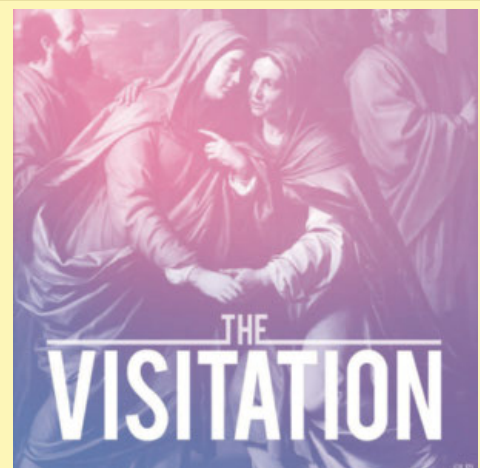

GOSPEL MEDITATION

May 25, 2025
6th Sunday of Easter

John 14:23-29

Jonathan Haidt's 2024 book entitled "The Anxious Generation" argues that today's kids are marked by significant increases in anxiety, as the title suggests. Smartphones, social media, economic uncertainty, the chaos of a global pandemic, fear regarding climate change, and the so-called "meaning crisis" all contribute to strikingly high levels of anxiety in young people today. I'm a bit older than this generation, but I feel it, too. The world can be too much to handle.

The Gospel this week offers a stunning solution for troubled souls. To his overwhelmed and anxious disciples, the risen Jesus says, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you" (John 14:27). His peace is that of the one who was overwhelmed on the cross and then conquered death by the power of his divinity, his bond of love with the Father. He offers us this unshakeable peace.

Of course, mental illness does not magically disappear because of the risen Jesus. But he does walk with us and offer us his peace in the midst of our suffering. The peace the world gives is not like his because it is weak, uncertain, and self-generated. Jesus' peace is strong, sure, and given as a gift from God. He gives it to us amid our anxiety. Will you receive it as a gift? I hope so. He wants to fill the hearts of this generation with his peace.

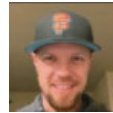
Our Lady of the Assumption 75th Jubilee Year 1950-2025

We welcome our new Maintenance Person, Jake Benjamin! He is married to an OLA Alumnus. They have 2 children attending OLA school this

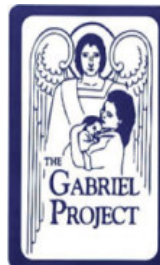

Interested in Becoming Catholic?

Are you interested in learning more about our rich Catholic faith and possibly becoming Catholic? Or do you know someone who is interested? Did you know that a person is brought into full communion with the Catholic Church through the reception of the three sacraments of Christian initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist? This occurs through the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults – OCIA (formerly known as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults – RCIA). The OCIA is for those who have never been baptized, those who have been baptized in another faith, or those who have been baptized Catholic and have not completed the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist.

If you are over the age of 16 and interested, inquiries will be held on the following Wednesdays: August 6th, 13th, 20th, and 27th. All sessions will be from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. in Affinito Hall, Meeting Room 3 (accessed via Cottage Way). You are welcome to join us at all four sessions and learn more! 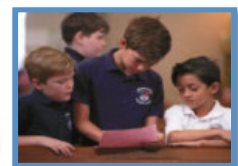

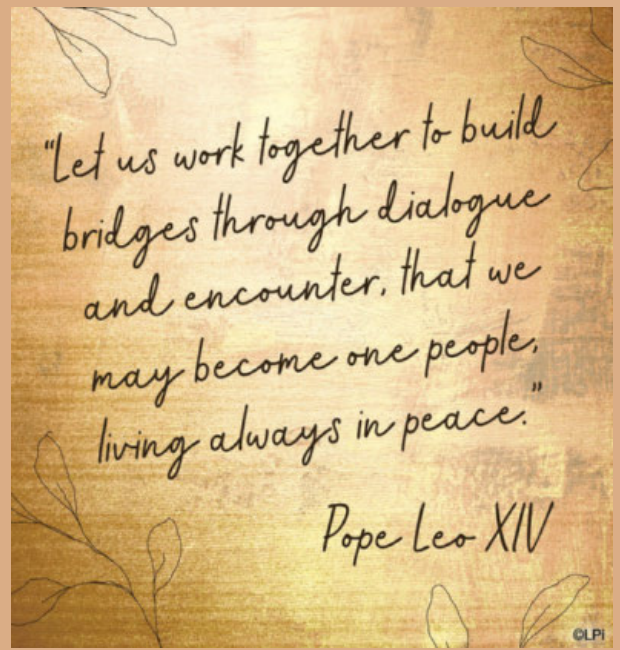

Radiate Love - May Reflection

Saint Monica was a devout Christian born in 4th-century Algeria. Married to Patricius, a nonbeliever, she navigated his emotional abuse and unfaithfulness as best she could. She prayed fervently for his conversion which finally came just a year before his death. Her greatest struggle was her son, Augustine, who rejected Christianity, joined Manichaeism, lived with a mistress, and fathered a child outside marriage. For nearly 20 years, Monica prayed persistently for his conversion, once hearing from a bishop, "The child of those tears shall never perish." She practiced tough love but ultimately chose to stay close to Augustine, urging him toward good influences, like St. Ambrose. Her prayers were answered in 387 when Augustine converted to Christianity. Monica died later that year, witnessing her son's transformation into a theologian and Doctor of the Church.
