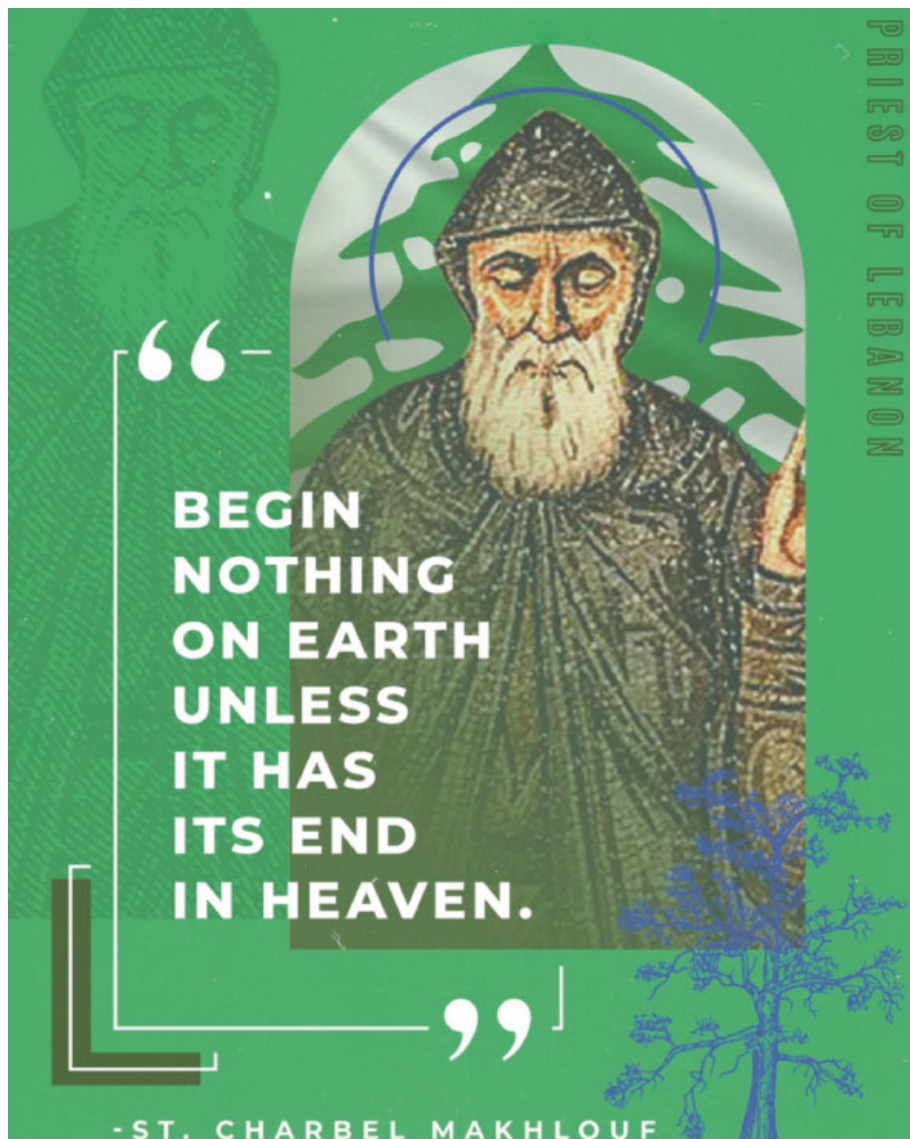

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

### 16<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Patience is rooted in Hope.

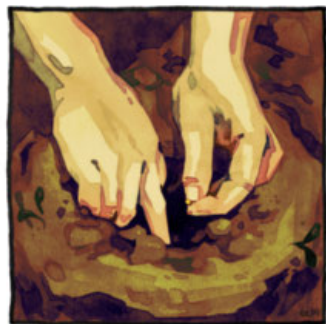
Life, like the church, is often burdened with evil, smallness, and impurities. The Lord's parables give us a hope-filled perspective on all three.

Evil: in Jesus' parable about the good farmer whose enemy plants weeds at night, Jesus tells us that God is not the cause of evil but permits evil to exist with good out of his patient love. He will finally deal with it, but his love lets things stay messy for a time.

Smallness: It's funny that Jesus says his kingdom looks like ... wait for it ... a bush. What a letdown! Yet this little shrub still somehow has room for all the birds of the sky. The smallness of the Church, and even our own little lives, still provides plenty of room for all whom God sends.

Impurities: divisions and hypocrisies in the Church and our own hearts exasperate us. Recall that Jesus compares his kingdom to a lump of dough with impure leaven eating away at it and therefore making it expand. It's the secret of the Cross. Not how we'd prefer it. But finally, great news.

The field, the bush, the loaf: all three parables invite us to embrace a patience rooted in hope: one day the field will be weeded, the bush filled with birds, and the risen loaf leaven-free. —Father John Muir ©LPI

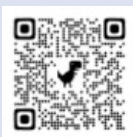

## St. John's Hall Landscape Eagle Scout Project Update



**Michael Mahnke, a parishioner and recent graduate of Our Lady of the Assumption School, completed his Eagle Scout Project, cleaning up and renovating a section of the St. John's Hall landscape.** In early Spring, Michael presented a plan to renovate the southwest section of the St. John's Hall landscape. His plan was to remove the dying lawn and a dying tree, to remove overgrown shrubbery, and to dig up and remove the old sprinklers. He replaced the lawn area with decomposed granite, planted new drought-resistant shrubs, installed new water-efficient sprinklers for the new shrubs, and laid down wood chips. He also brought in some benches which in consultation with Father Eduino were placed along the north wall of the church providing a place to sit in the shade. Michael submitted the plan for Father Eduino's approval, then began fundraising for the project. After raising the funds, he organized and supervised two workdays, using the parish's Boy Scout Troop 328 to renovate the area.

The area provides a cleaner look to St. John's Hall and the walkway between the church and Affinito Hall. It also provides an area that can be used by our social committee volunteers to barbeque meals for our various parish dinners. Michael raised more than enough funds to complete his Eagle project and will donate all leftover funds to the Parish, as expressed in his plan.

**Thank you to Michael Mahnke, BSA Troop 328, and the parishioners at the Sunday morning Masses who donated towards the project!** Michael will be addressing the 9 and 11 am Masses on Sunday morning, July 23<sup>rd</sup>. After the 9 am Mass, Father will bless the newly renovated area.
