





DIOCESAN MISSIONARY COOPERATIVE APPEAL: This weekend August 17/18, we will hear from Fr. Francis Nusi on behalf of the Holy Spirit nuns, a missionary society in south India that serves destitute and homeless senior citizens who have been abandoned by their families. Today, close to 18 million elderly people in India are homeless. Without an old age home to support them, many elderly are left alone and unable to earn an income after their children move to the cities in search of a better livelihood. All funds collected throughout the Diocese will be equally divided among the 50 missionary organizations visiting the Diocese of Sacramento this year.

#### **GOSPEL MEDITATION**

#### 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

A priest I know was asked by a door-to-door evangelist, "Do you believe in Jesus?" He answered, "Yes, I do. But if I may ask you," he continued, "Where do you experience Jesus' body and blood?" His interlocutor responded somewhat confusedly, "I don't. I just believe in him. That's all that is needed." Later my priest friend would relate to me, "The more I thought about it, that response struck me as totally inadequate. As human beings, we need to encounter Jesus' body and blood, not just hear about him and mentally believe. Otherwise, Jesus is just a ghost."

This week we see this central point as we arrive at the climactic moment of Jesus' teaching on the Eucharist. Jesus has established the importance of believing in him as the "bread of life come down from heaven." Belief deeply matters because it leads to a real, bodily encounter with Jesus through eating and drinking. That's why Jesus emphasizes to an almost outrageous degree the non-metaphorical necessity to "eat my flesh and drink my blood." (John 6:54) The real presence of Jesus' body and blood - he himself, truly, really, substantially — has been the Church's treasure since Holy Thursday. Internal belief in the heart and the ritual act of eating and drinking the Eucharist, the Church has stubbornly insisted on both, not just one or the other.

This is not meant to criticize non-Catholic Christians who deeply trust and love Jesus, nor is it a triumphal elitist claim about the Catholic Mass. Rather it is a humble, trusting acknowledgement that God in Jesus comes to us in a way most proper to human beings: in our hearts and our bodies, faith and the Eucharist. – Father John Muir ©LPi

This client story is part of a monthly series for the parish bulletin that shows the different kinds of assistance offered to clients who live within our parish boundaries by the OLA Conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society.

Client Story from Team 4: It is Wednesday morning, 9:30 am. The phone rings and on the line is an Afghan man seeking assistance to pay his rent. He had been ill and missed a week of work. His budget is tight with his wife and 4 children. After some discussion we offered him a modest amount to help pay his rent. We also told him about our food bank and the great help that it could provide to his family. And we told him of the SVDP Thrift Store on Watt Avenue and the low prices they have there for clothes, kitchen and home appliances. A normal day at Our Lady of the Assumption SVDP office.

But what made this normal day special was the relief in his voice that he had found someone who could help him. The thankfulness and gratitude that he expressed gave our team a warm feeling and made us realize that yes, the work we do is important and matters to people's lives. In re: The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento, Case No. 24-21326 U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of California

Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: October 1, 2024

YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.


