This weekend is Catechetical Sunday!

At our 9:00am Sunday Mass this weekend, we will pray for and commission our catechists. Parents are the primary educators of the faith for their children, but our entire community shares in this important task.

We thank all of our OLA catechists for their dedicated and loving service at OLA Parish and School.



The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has designated the third Sunday in September as Catechetical Sunday. Per the USCCB, "Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of Baptism, in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. Catechetical Sunday is an opportunity for all to rededicate themselves to this mission as a community of faith.

'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me... to bring good news to the poor' (Lk 4:18; cf. Is 61:1) reveals Jesus' mission and identity. Anointed by the Holy Spirit, he is sent to bring hope, healing, and freedom—especially to the poor, the brokenhearted, and the forgotten. This passage shows that the Messiah comes not with power or status, but with compassion, restoring dignity and proclaiming God's mercy. It also becomes a model for the Church, us, which is called to continue Christ's work by sharing the Good News and caring for those most in need."
