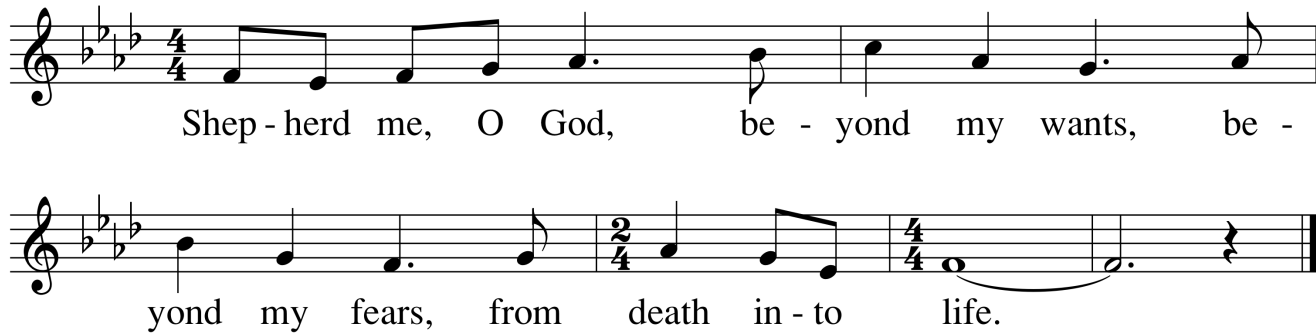
## Act of Spiritual Communion
